Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA)

St. Peter's has been blessed with the gift of 6 candidates and 1 catechumen who are praying and learning on a journey of faith to become full members of the Catholic Church. They are in their second stage of preparation, called the Catechumenate Period.

This is a time of immersion into our faith and the community of St. Peter's.

It requires the full support and care of all the church members to support and welcome our candidates and catechumens. Their initiation happens within the church community and they learn from us—our example of prayer, service and love show them the way to full discipleship. You are their example and mentor in their apprenticeship in the Catholic Christian way of life.

Each of us is called to spread the message of our faith in words and actions in our daily lives. By sharing our beliefs through conversation, offering warm and open hospitality, and by demonstrating our service commitment to others, we teach and welcome those seeking God into our parish lives in a special way. Over the next few months, you will have the opportunity during community gatherings and our general worship to pray and work with our catechumens and candidates and to show them the true spirit of love and service at St. Peter's.
