We also need help "patch sitting". The sign up sheet to unload pumpkins and for patch sitting can be found in the back of the church.



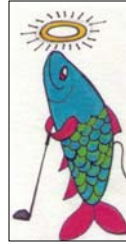
Thank you for supporting St. Peter Youth Ministry!
